Time saving livery film range

The research and development team at Reflexite has been busy again, this time designing a labour and time saving livery film that still has the unique safety and durability benefits of the existing Reflexite range. The new film, VC312R, comprises a double layer of adhesive thickness meaning that it is much easier to remove when decommissioning or repairing accident damaged vehicles.

VC312R livery film for vehicles has been specifically developed to reduce the amount of time it takes in labour and manpower after accidents or when decommissioning, importantly getting vehicles back on the road quickly. This reduction in time and manpower means cost savings as this new film can be removed without leaving pieces stuck to the vehicle, which can take up valuable time. With time and labour costs at a critical level, especially in these difficult times, this film has been welcomed with open arms by users and converters alike, especially as this new film still does not compromise any of the benefits of the original VC312 film making this new family member a welcome addition to the range.



Visibility and safety

Of course, as with all research and development at Reflexite, of utmost importance in this development was the visibility and safety aspect of the livery film and VC312R is no different from other Reflexite livery films, maintaining the ultimate brightness and vibrancy for daytime, dawn and dusk and increased visibility for night time.

As the entire range of reflective livery film, including the new VC312R, does not need edge sealing, it means that accident damaged panels can be cut from rolls further reducing downtime, with considerable savings in material and labour over the lifetime of a vehicle. This also means the panel edges do not turn black through water and dirt ingress from power washing and day to day operating conditions which means warranty is not compromised.

Being safe and being seen is vital for fleets on the road, as is a quick turnaround when replacing, decommissioning and repairing damaged vehicles. Reflexite's® VC312R livery film, available in white, yellow, green, blue and red, is designed to meet the requirements of busy fleet departments and manufacturers in the 21st Century landscape.
